# Victorian Rural Health Conference

## Student Grant Application Guidelines 2018

## Background

Rural Workforce Agency Victoria (RWAV) is a non-profit government funded organisation improving healthcare for rural, regional and Aboriginal communities in Victoria. RWAV and the Rural Doctors' Association Victoria (RDAV) are bringing rural health professionals together to learn and connect at the Victorian Rural Health Conference 2018.

The aim of this grant is to offer financial support for costs associated with conference registration, basic accommodation and some meals, excluding travel.

## Eligibility

Students must be studying for a degree in medicine at a Victorian University campus.

#### Requirements

 Sponsored medical students must be available to attend the full conference at RACV Goldfields Resort in Creswick from 27<sup>th</sup> – 29<sup>th</sup> April 2018.

## Application process

- Applications must be submitted to RWAV using the Victorian Rural Health Conference Student Grant Application Form which can be accessed on the RWAV website www.rwav.com.au
- Applicants must complete all required sections, supply all required documentation and ensure the application form is signed (digital signatures are accepted) prior to submission.

## Application assessment

- All grants will be assessed and successful recipients determined by the Future Workforce Program.
- All applicants will be notified via email of the outcome of their application within two weeks of applications closing.

- who are Bonded medical students ; and
