



BACKGROUND

All results are from a survey of general practitioners conducted in rural and regional Victoria (MMM2-7) and in Geelong (MMM1) between the 15th of November and 15th of December 2019. The survey was conducted to understand GP workforce (MMM1) between the 15th of November and 15th of December 2019. The survey was sent out to 2029 unique GPs and statistics and role data (e.g., advanced skills practiced, VMO rights). The survey was sent out to 2029 unique GPs and registrars, with a response rate of 18.88% (N = 383).

WORKFORCE DEMOGRAPHICS






HOURS SPENT IN GENERAL PRACTICE


Mean hours spent in general practice (n=364).


